There was then the opportunity to go outside and visit Mrs Vicary, who had the fire pit all ready and set up. The children helped mix the dough, whittle their own stick for the fire and place the dough on the stick to bake bread on the fire. The children all thoroughly enjoyed this part and the eating of course. Lastly the children had lots of fun creating pieces of art using different mediums to represent the fire. What a fab day.

HEALTHY LIFESTYLES AND EATING

As part of the national agenda on Healthy Lifestyles we will continue to promote and maintain our healthy eating approach. The children learn about healthy lifestyles through Science and PE. They understand the need for a balanced diet and how exercise will enable them to feel fitter and healthier. I know that the vast

majority of the children at school participate in either clubs in or outside of school and take an active role during PE lessons. It was positive that during lockdown walking was promoted as a main form of exercise and I am sure that as families you took the opportunity to either walk or cycle around the local area. We need to ensure that the children have healthy lunchboxes and food snacks during the day. We recognise that currently the schools meals are not fully operational due to the reduced menu choices. However, once we start the next academic year the full



menu will commence providing the children with a wide range of healthy meal choices. We ask that parents sending children into school with home packed lunches that you limit the number of high fat items such as chocolate and crisps if possible. We can now announce that we have appointed Mrs Samantha McDowall who will join the Almondsbury team as our new SENCo replacing Mrs Duffy. Mrs McDowall is an experienced SENCo from another local school in Bradley Stoke and I am sure will be another asset to our staff. She will be visiting school over this term to familiarise herself with the children and meet some parents at the same time.



RECEPTION FUNDRAISING

An update on the fundraising exploits of the Reception class. The total they have raised is a very impressive £804.00. Well done to the 47 children in Reception and of course their parents and families for donating so much money. The classes will use the money to purchase new role play structures and resources. The children are looking forward to having these in their classrooms very shortly.



The week before half term during Sports Week was our Walk to School week as well. The children collected points for the times they walked to school either from their homes or from a parking location away from the school like the garden centre. There were two winning classes for each key stage. The winners are in Key Stage 1 in 1st place with 783 points Mrs North's class and in 2nd place with 759 points Mr Garcia's class. In Key Stage 2 in 1st place with 828 points Mrs Long and Mrs Duffy's class and in 2nd place with 717 – Mr Evens's class. All children receive an extra playtime, gold pot stars and a treat. Well done to those classes and to everyone else who tried really hard to walk to school. As the weather seems to be improving and the sun will sunshine hopefully the walking will be maintained.
