# SCHOOL YEAR 2021/2022 - NEWSLETTER NO 1

# Welcome back to school It's great to see you!

Welcome back to all parents and children. I do hope that you have had a lovely summer holiday and been able to have some relaxation and recuperation and managed to get away either on a staycation or ventured further afield. Hopefully we will have a more stable and regular routine this term and into the future.

I would like to welcome all of the new children in Reception and new parents who will be joining us this week. I am sure you and your child will have seven wonderful years at Almondsbury. All of the staff look forward to getting to know your children as well as yourselves.

## **COVID UPDATE**

We are hopeful that this year we can return to some form of normality in school. As the rules changed on periods of isolation in August, we don't envisage many situations when this will be applied to us in school to whole classes. However, we do need to remain vigilant as cases are still above 30,000 per day. The updated guidance has been published by the DFE which states that any positive cases must still self-isolate. However, contacts of positive cases who are under 18 years old or are double vaccinated are not required to self-isolate.

If your child begins to show signs or symptoms of COVID, then please book a test for them as soon as possible. Whilst waiting for the results of the test to be returned we would ask that you do not send your child into school. This will slow or halt the transmission of the virus. As a school we have a responsibility for the general health and safety of all pupils and staff. Therefore, should there be a positive case within the school parents will receive a 'Warn and Inform' letter to let them know of the positive case within the class. It is then for parents to make decisions as to whether they would choose to arrange a PCR test for their child to rule out any worries in case of transmission. If there are more than 5 cases within a class or across the staff/school we will invoke our Outbreak Management Plan and isolate the children involved with either a return to class bubbles or alternative arrangements for teaching and learning. I have attached our updated whole school risk assessment and the Outbreak Management Plan for parents to read through and become familiar with. We will be following and using the guidance from the DFE. Here is the link
