GENERAL SCHOOL UPDATE

Welcome to our new Reception children and their families. It is so lovely to have you all here with us at Almondsbury. The children had super time on their Teddy Bear's picnic and their first day of school.

This will make it easier for your children (and their class teachers) to see you at the end of the day to be dismissed. It is really busy out there and there are so many parents picking up altogether now we are all exiting school at the same time. Thank you.



Please remember we are a nut free school. This includes any foods that contain nuts as well such as Nutella, etc. Please do ensure you check your child's packed lunch as to whether anything contains nuts. We have children in school who are extremely allergic to peanuts, in particular, and would need hospital treatment should they come into contact with nuts. Thank you for your consideration.
