TIMES TABLES ROCKSTARS



Last Tuesday, Year 3 and 4 took part in a 'Times Tables Rockstars' Launch Day. The children dressed up as rock stars and they all took part in a number of activities, including designing their own rock star characters, times tables games and exploring the use of Times Tables Rockstars. Times Tables Rockstars is a fantastic app that can be used to support the recall of times tables facts. It is fun, interactive and

engages children to improve on the areas mentioned above. However, as a school, we want to maximize this potential. There will be monthly awards, class battles and house battles where children can gain house points. These will be added onto the house points tally and contribute towards the winning house at the end of each term. It is also helpful to prepare children for the Multiplication Check at the end of Year 4. The Multiplication Check determines whether pupils can recall their times tables fluently, which is essential for future success in mathematics.



WELLBEING FORTNIGHT

During Wellbeing fortnight, Year 1 and 2 read the lovely picture book, The Sky Garden by Linda Sarah and Fiona Lumbers. This story inspired the children to design and write about their own secret gardens, design and make kites to fly, sketch the school grounds, and consider how we can help to improve the school environment by putting litter in the bins and looking after all the equipment. We finished the fortnight with team building games and songs around the fire pit.



Year 3 and 4 had a wonderful first two weeks in school, taking part in activities based around the book 'The Promise'. These activities included a nature walk and writing poetry, building dioramas of cities, making marshmallow and spaghetti towers and creating postcards with our visions for the future. All of the children enjoyed our Wellbeing Fortnight, learning lots about how to care for our environment, and are looking forward to the rest of the year.



Year 5 and 6 have based their learning for well-being fortnight around The Promise. We went out for walks to explore the local area and created poetry inspired by our observations in nature. We have also created artwork linked to being outside. We have discussed how to effectively deal with worries and had a go at making our own worry dolls to help with this.



CLUBS

We now have a full list of the clubs that will be available for the Autumn term. The letters for the clubs being run by teachers, if after school will be sent out this week. If clubs run during lunchtime the children will be asked to sign up. We have struggled slightly with finding providers to run some of the clubs.
