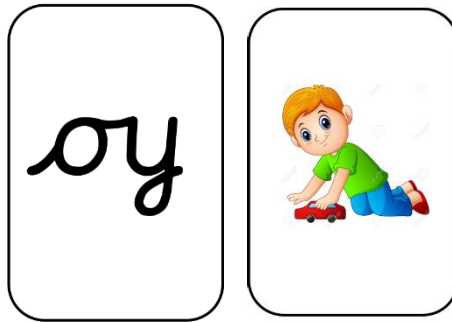


Tuesday 21st April 2020

uses for boy - pretend to cut beard off by
moving index finger straight under chin.



This oy sound usually goes at the **end** of words.
