

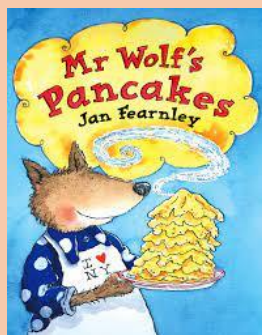
Learning in Reception this week...

Phonics

This week we have learnt our next 2 sounds, these are digraphs, they have 2 letters but make 1 sound. This digraph is special because it makes 2 different sounds!

Can you find things at home with these sounds?

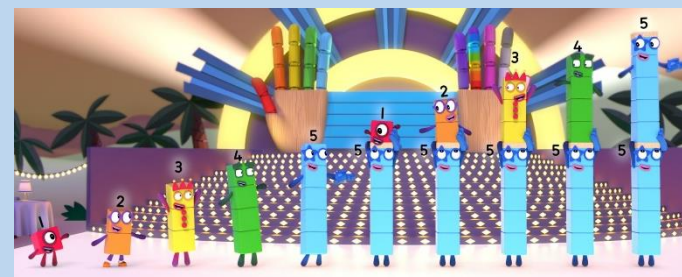
Sound	Visual	Action	Digraph Rhyme
oo	poo 	Waft hand in front of nose.	oo, oo, poo at the zoo
oo	book 	Make circles with hands and put them to eyes like glasses.	oo, oo, look at a book

Maths

This week we have looked at the structure of numbers from 1-10.

We have learnt that when the numbers are in order they resemble steps/ stairs as 1 more is added each time.

We also practised making numbers starting with 5 and adding a bit more to make 6, 7, 8, 9, 10.



We have also introduced capacity to the children, using the terms **empty, nearly empty, half full, nearly full, full**. The children loved having their own cup and filling them with various resources to make them full, half full etc. We also compared containers to see which would hold the most/ least etc.

Discovery Detectives – This week we celebrated Pancake Day – Shrove Tuesday! We enjoyed learning how to make pancakes and tasting them! In Drawing Club this week we have written instructions to make pancakes and designed our own perfect pancakes with lots of delicious toppings! In PE we loved taking part in pancake races and obstacle courses too! In RE, we learnt about the reason behind Pancake Day – Lent. The children discussed what they might give up for Lent, some ideas included their toys, tablets and chocolate!
