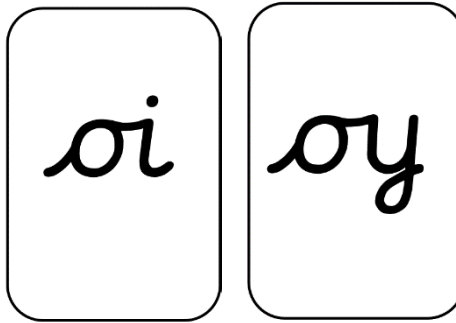


Wednesday 22nd April 2020

The Phonics Fairy says

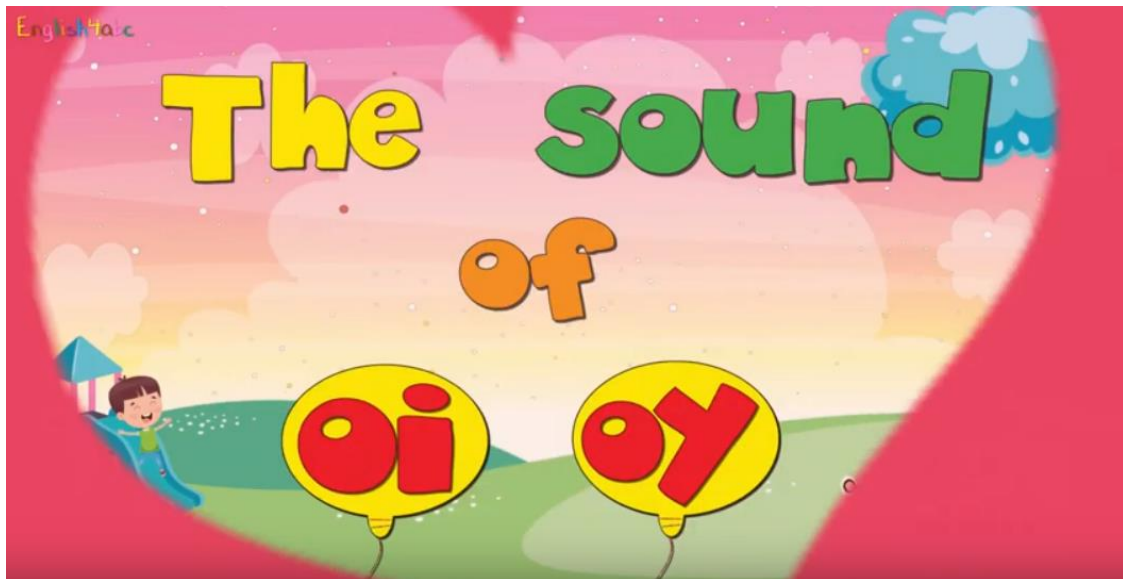
“oi, oi, boil the oil.”
