HM THE QUEEN ELIZABETH II

As you know the funeral of the late Her Majesty The Queen Elizabeth II is taking place on Monday 19 September. This date has been made a Bank Holiday and therefore the school will be closed to all pupils and staff. We will be looking at her late Majesty's legacy with the children in school. We hope to mark this with something that will be a permanent commemoration of HM The Queen Elizabeth II.

YEAR 6 RESIDENTIAL - We are awaiting notification from PGL regarding the arrangements for the Year 6 visit to Paris, France that begins on Monday 19 September. We are hopeful that the residential visit will continue as planned as transport will still be running and operating on the day. Year 6 parents will be informed as soon as we have the correct information.

READING - Following an update from the Department for Education around phonics teaching we have moved to a new phonics scheme called Essential Letters and Sounds. It is a rigorous programme that will support your children in making quick progress to become fluent and confident readers. Reception will be starting this week and Year 1 started the first day back! The English Team will be in touch this week to give you more information about an upcoming phonics workshop for parents in Key Stage 1. There will also be changes taking place with how reading is structured at home so please watch this space!

MATHS ATTACK

Mastery of Maths - 'Mastering maths means pupils acquiring a deep long-long term, secure and adaptable understanding of the subject.'

'Achieving mastery means acquiring a solid enough understanding of the maths that's been taught to enable pupils to move on to more advanced material.'

Last year, the school trialled the Mastery of Maths approach. The trial proved to be successful and this year we are rolling out this approach throughout the whole school. In order to keep in line with the Mastery approach, we have decided to change our Maths Attack scheme.

The new Mastery Maths Attack scheme will focus on the skills and facts needed for the year group the children are currently working in. They will have 2 or three weeks (depending on year group) to challenge themselves on each level. Following this period, the children will move to the next level. More information will be given during the Meet the Teacher sessions this week.

CONGRATULATIONS - We have very happy news to share with everyone. Mrs North is expecting a baby, due in mid-February 2023. We are all very happy for her and look forward to the birth of second baby North. When Mrs North does leave school to go on maternity leave, Ms Hill will become full time to teach the children in Reception 2.

PE KIT

As usual we are straight back into all aspects of school life including PE and Forest School. As part of this healthy attitude to physical activity, we would like to remind all the children that it is essential to be properly prepared to participate. This is a reminder of the request that children come into school in their PE kits on their allotted PE days. The children have been told, a timetable has been put into the school newsletter and the days will be published on each class's webpage on the website.
