




Drawing Club Vocabulary

Welly Wednesday

This week the children enjoyed finding out what seeds came from which tree - exploring **conkers, acorns and maple seeds**. They learnt about the **life cycle** of a seed and what they need to grow. They all took turns **digging and planting** daffodil and crocus bulbs ready for us to look at in the Spring. They also took part in a **nature colour hunt**, finding lots of different natural colours!

Maths

This week we learnt about the **number one**. We found things with a number 1 on: 1p coin, 1 o'clock, 1 spot on a dice, one & 1.

We also learnt about shapes with 1 side – **circle & oval** and went on a shape hunt in the classroom to find circles and ovals.

We used 2 cubes to explore that “**one and another one makes two**”.
