<u>Welly Wednesday</u>

The children found out about **how trees look** and **what they do through each season**. They split into groups and worked together to hunt for natural resources to create a picture for each season. They showed great creativity and shared their ideas within their groups, using twigs, branches, leaves, grass and flowers.

<u>Maths</u>

This week we learnt about the **number two**. We found things with a number 2 on: 2p coin, 2 o'clock, 2 spots on a dice, 2 spots on a domino (1&1 and 2&0). We also found things that come in **pairs** – socks, shoes and gloves. We found out about a shape which has 2 sides and 2 corners – a **semi-circle**.

We used 2 cubes to explore that **"one and another one makes two"**. We also learnt how to represent the number 2 by drawing 2 things, e.g. 2 lines, 2 dots, 2 crosses.
