<u>Welly Wednesday</u>

This week the children learnt the difference between deciduous and evergreen trees. They found out why some trees lose their leaves and others keep them all year round. We explored pine, yew, holly and laurel leaves using our senses. We described what they looked like, how they felt and what they smelled like. The children used some great vocabulary such as spikey, bumpy, smooth, tickly, waxy and shiny.

<u>Maths</u>

This week we learnt about the **number three**. We found things with a number 3 on: 3 spots on a dice, 3 spots on a domino (3&0, 2&1), 3 o'clock 3 x 1p coins, a 2p and 1p, the word 'three' and numeral '3'. We also thought about the 3 Little Pigs and 3 Bears.

We learnt "1 and another 1 and another 1 makes 3".

We also learnt about triangles, they have 3 sides and 3 corners. We used 3 sticks to make our own triangles.
