We focused this year on the work of the farmers to tend the land and harvest the crops that we eat and how thankful we should be for this. bank namely the Five Loaves and Two Fishes charity of St Paul's in Bristol. The loaves were shared during the afternoon with all of the

BOOK WEEK



Straight after half term when we return on Tuesday 1 November, it is our annual Book Week. We have linked this in with our Diversity week which starts today. There are lots of exciting things happening. We have the Book Fair every evening after school from 3.30 - 4.00pm in the library area, Big Read, drop everything and read sessions, reading swaps lessons, homework linked to reading and dressing up day on Friday. On Tuesday you are invited into the library for a

reading breakfast from 8.15am. We also have our Book at Bedtime on Wednesday evening from 6.00-7.00pm alongside a workshop for parents on reading plus time to buy any books secretly when the children are otherwise engaged. A letter came home last Friday with more details.

SCHOOL LUNCHES

There have been many changes recently to school lunches. We can but apologise for these changes, especially those that have been made at short notice. Unfortunately, these have been out of our control. Some of the changes have been due to supply or delivery issues with various parts of the menu ie no BBQ sauce for Hunter's chicken or beans rather than beans and peas. Others have been due to staffing issues. If we have a member or two members of staff out sick then there may have to be changes to the menu choice due to the time it takes to create/cook certain meals for that many children. We run a four person kitchen, however for the past year we have only had either two or three at the most members of catering staff in the kitchen. This limits the capacity of the team. This is a local authority wide issues with sickness and also recruitment to posts that have not been filled for a long time.

Hopefully, these will be resolved somewhat with the new menu that will be sent out shortly to start in Term 2. Please do bear with us though as we want to do our best to make sure the children are fed properly at school.

PACKED LUNCHES

We also have noticed that for some children their packed lunch boxes are starting to be filled with sweets, lollipops and lots of chocolate. We want to discourage these types of choices in lunchboxes. Not only are they lacking in nutrition but lollipops are dangerous and not needed here in school for lunchtimes. Please do not send these items in lunchboxes. Can I also remind you that we are a nut free school so no nuts or bars containing nuts should be present in lunchboxes. Thank you for your co-operation on this.

FREE SCHOOL MEALS

This even applies to children in Reception and KS1 who are already entitled to Universal Free School Meals as this brings in additional funding to support your child.



CHARLIE FROUD FOUNDATION
