Welly Wednesday

This week the children enjoyed getting muddy this week, we had an **animal cafe** and made all sorts of things to put on our menu, from dirt burgers and mud pies to stick bolognaise and slimy soup. The children then couldn't resist having lots of fun splashing and playing in the puddles.



Phonics

This week we have learnt the sounds:

nk ai ee igh

We have now learnt all of the Phase 2 phonic sounds and have moved onto Phase 3 which includes digraphs (2 letters that make 1 sound).



<u>Maths</u>

This week we learnt about **number five**. We found things with the number on e.g. 5 fingers, 5 toes, a glove, 5p coin, 5 spots on a dice, a star with 5 points etc.

We watched the 'Off we go' Numberblocks episode and have been practising putting the numbers **0-5** in the correct order, using the language first, before, after, last.

We recapped all the shapes we have learnt so far and discussed their properties — number of sides and corners. We then learnt about a **pentagon**, having **5 sides and corners**.

Amazing Artists

This week we learnt more about our new artist for the term — **Wassily Kandinsky**, a Russian Painter. We recapped the **primary colours** — **red, yellow** and **blue** and **secondary colours** — **orange, purple** and **green**. We explored using paint to **print circles** within circles using a variety of materials.



<u>Discovery Detectives</u> (<u>History, Geography, Science</u>)

This week we learnt about space and in particular the moon. We learnt about the different phases of the moon and learnt the words whole, half and crescent. We have learnt the names of the planets in the solar system and some facts about them. We found out about the British astronaut Tim Peake and watched videos of astronauts in space doing everyday tasks like having lunch and brushing their teeth, which is very funny with no gravity to hold things down!
