

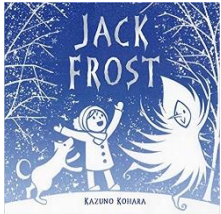


Drawing Club Vocabulary

We have now learnt all of the Phase 2 phonic sounds and have moved onto Phase 3 which includes digraphs (2 letters that make 1 sound).



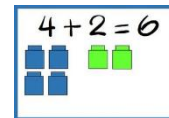
Maths

We also revisited the 'add' symbol and the STEM sentence - **'When we add, the number gets bigger.'**

We used cubes to help us find the answers to number sentences (addition sums).

Discovery Detectives (History, Geography, Science)

This week we have started to learn about **Winter**. We have been looking at **signs of winter** – colder weather, bare trees, wearing different clothes and so on.

We discussed how we can **keep warm** in winter and that some animals and birds hibernate or migrate to stay warm.



Welly Wednesday

This term we will be **learning about the weather**. This week we explored **wind** and talked about all the ways wind can help us, from **turning windmills** to **power electricity**, **blowing sails** to make boats move, **blowing seeds** around to help plants grow to **drying washing** out on a line. The children made **wind socks**, they decorated them with leaves and stuck colourful tails on them so that they could see **which way the wind was blowing**. They then had lots of fun with them making them fly!
