Phonics

This week we have learnt the sounds:

ure er ow (snow)

We have now learnt all of the Phase 2 phonic sounds and have moved onto Phase 3 which includes digraphs (2 letters that make 1 sound).



Maths

This week we have been exploring subtraction. We learnt that **'When we subtract/ take away, the number gets smaller.'**

We have been practising reading subtraction number sentences (sums) and using cubes to find the answers.

We also explored drawing items to represent the starting quantity and then crossing them out to find the answer.



This week we continued our learning about our artist for the term – **Piet Mondrian**, a Dutch painter. We explored **printing** using paint and squares and rectangles to recreate our own version of his famous painting.
