<u>Real</u> <u>Superheroes</u>

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<u>Welly Wednesday</u>

This week we became **eco heroes**! We learnt about conservation and what we could do to **save our planet**. We discussed how we could be **eco-friendly** and went on a **litter picking hunt** around the field, working together to find all the rubbish. We then **sorted** the rubbish into groups for **recycling** - plastic, card/paper and metal. We found out that some things can't be recycled but that we must always put them in the bin.



Phonics

We have learnt all of the Phase 2 and 3 phonic sounds. We are now reviewing what we have learnt and are practising reading and writing these sounds in words.



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<u>Maths</u>

This week we have been learning about the **number 8**. We found things that **represent** the number – a spider (8 legs), an octopus (8 tentacles), an octagon (8 sides and 8 corners), Numicon, dominoes – 8 & 0, 6 & 2, 5 & 3, 4 & 4 etc. We used cubes and **part, part, whole** models to find ways of making 8. We also looked at doubling and halving numbers up to 8, using the Numberblocks episode below.

We have also been learning about the mass of items and using the mathematical vocabulary – **light, lighter, lightest, heavy, heavier and heaviest**. We have been using the **bucket balance scales** to weigh items and have been explaining how we know if they are **heavy or light** (heavy the bucket goes down, light the bucket goes up). We have explored some items which are big but light and small but heavy, to address the misconception of all big things being heavy.

This week we continued learning about the **Qur'an**, including being respectful, washing hands before touching it, keeping it up high and the special stand that it rests on.
