INDUSTRIAL ACTION

As you will be aware industrial action is being taken by certain teaching unions. This is being taken for a number of reasons.

- The teaching profession is facing a severe recruitment crisis.
- The education sector has been underfunded for years and it is increasingly difficult to finance high quality education for all pupils.
- The recent pay award was below inflation, plus schools were not given money in their budgets to fund this pay award.

I have spoken to a number of governors on how the industrial action will impact on our school. Due to the planned industrial action, I have to inform you that parts of the school will be closed to pupils as a result of insufficient teaching staff. The parents of the classes that will not be in school on Wednesday 1 February will be emailed a letter by Wednesday this week. The following information is also important to you.

- The children who have EHCP's will be in school as their support will remain in place.
- Breakfast club will still run for those who remain in school as will after school provision as these are not effected by the industrial action.
- Remote learning will not be provided as there is insufficient teaching staff to provide this.
- There will not be provision for pupils whose parents are key workers.

Please note that each school has to make arrangements based on their individual circumstances and number of teachers taking industrial action. Those teaching staff who are not part of the NEU's industrial action and all support staff will remain in school to continue as normal.

Please be aware that this is the first date the planned industrial action that has been called. The following dates will also have the same impact unless otherwise stated should they go ahead. Unions need to provide 2 weeks' notice of any further industrial action.

- Thursday 2 March 2022 for all eligible members in the South West region.
- Wednesday 15 and Thursday 16 March for all eligible members in England and Wales.
