HOLIDAY ACTIVITIES AND FOOD CLUBS

The local authority run holiday activities and food clubs for all pupils in certain locations around South Gloucestershire, the nearest ones for our school are in Bradley Stoke, Patchway and Thornbury. The clubs can be attended by any pupil within the age ranges that they are applicable for. There is also a free provision for those who receive benefits and free school meals. NSPCC ONLINE SAFETY WORKSHOPS FOR PARENTS

We all know that online safety is a very important part of safeguarding and how we can keep our children safe from harm. The children have regular lessons on this in school. However, apart from the online e-safety briefings we provide for you monthly there is very little else. The NSPCC have now started to offer online workshops for parents. PARKING

This is the usual plea to parents regarding safe parking in and around the village. We also request that parents do not park in front of the school gates to park or drop off the children. These gates are needing to be left for staff to come in and out of the school as well as emergencies.



CHARLIE FROUD FOUNDATION

The charity support mountain rescue teams as well as other local charities such as the Jesse May Trust. The children have been set the challenge of collecting as many
