Drawing Club Vocabulary

Each week the children learn new words relating to our theme of the week. They learn an action to help them remember each word. Ask your child about the words we have been learning this week.

- Royal
- Buckingham Palace
- Monarch
- Coronation

Phonics

This term we will continue to review the sounds and hard to read and spell words we have learnt so far in Reception.

This week we have continued practising reading and writing **CVCC words** (consonant, vowel, consonant, consonant), e.g. sand, tent, jump

We have also learnt that the **suffix '-ed'** can also make a **'d'** sound, e.g. burned, turned



Amazing Artists

This week, to link in with our learning about **collaging**, we created a **Coronation collage**.

We used images of London, items relating to the King and red, white and blue items to collage a crown shape in our art books.



Maths

This week we continued to learn the next **teen number - 15**.

Number 15 is also known as the **'Step Squad'** because

$$1 + 2 + 3 + 4 + 5 = 15!$$

We also practised finding number 15 on the number line and making it in different ways:

$$5 + 5 + 5, 10 + 5, 9 + 6$$


Discovery Detectives (History, Geography, Science)
