

This Friday we will be holding our own Coronation celebrations in school with traditional games, a party and finding out all about HM King Charles III. ### WRITING AT ALMONDSBURY

At Almondsbury, we use high-quality texts linked to our topics as a stimulus for writing. Across each year group, the children will write a range of genres for a variety of audiences and purposes. They often start their writing journey by exploring good quality examples of texts, ready to 'magpie' ideas. With some writing units, we use Talk for Writing approaches, which allow the children to learn a text off by heart with actions, helping them to understand the structure of different text types and giving them excellent ideas for vocabulary. This also helps the children to develop their oracy and performance skills.



In Reception and at the start of Year 1, the children take part in Drawing Club, which helps them to develop their confidence as writers. Again, this is linked to high quality texts and encourages the children to explore stories through drawings, words and then gradually builds up to sentences. We have been so pleased with the progress that the children have been able to make as writers in EFYS and Year 1 with this approach. We also have high expectations and awards for the development of neat, cursive handwriting as taught within school. These are celebrated every Friday in worship so that pupils get the recognition they deserve for the effort they are putting into their handwriting.
