This week the children found out about **how trees look** and **what they do through each season**. They split into groups and worked together to hunt for natural resources to create a picture for each season. They showed great creativity and shared their ideas within their groups, using twigs, branches, leaves, grass and flowers.

<u>Maths</u>

This week we learnt about the **number two**. We found things which represent the number 2: 2 spots on a dice, two & 2, Numberblock 2, 2 spots on a domino (1+1, 2+0) a 2p coin, 2 x 1p coins and a pair of socks. We also learnt about a shape with 2 sides — **semi-circle** and learnt that 2 semi-circles make a circle.

We used 2 cubes to explore that "one and another one makes two".

We have also been **comparing quantities** using the language of **more**, **fewer** and **equal**.



Amazing Artists

This week we recapped British animator **Nick Park**. We looked at some more of the characters he has created including **Morph** and enjoyed watching an episode of the Morph animation. We then used playdough and tools to create a **3d playdough head**.



<u>Discovery Detectives</u> (<u>History, Geography, Science</u>)

This week we have been learning about **squirrels** and how they gather nuts and acorns for winter.

We have looked at features of squirrels including their sharp claws, bushy tails, big eyes and having a good sense of smell.

We also discussed **friendship** and the new friends we have made since starting school.

This week we learnt all about **harvest**. We attended the **harvest festival** with the rest of the school and helped to display the food which the children donated.
