
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Soaring

Welly Wednesday

This week we recapped British woodland **animals** and found out about the **habitats** where they live. We learnt the names for badger, fox, rabbit and squirrel homes - sett, den, burrow, drey. We explored the forest school area and looked for locations of where their homes could be and then created our own woodland habitat.



Phonics

This week we have learnt the sounds:

ai ee igh oa

We have now learnt all of the Phase 2 phonic sounds and have moved onto Phase 3 which includes digraphs (2 letters that make 1 sound).

Maths

This week we learnt about **number five**. We found things that represent 5 e.g. 5 fingers, 5 toes, a glove, 5p coin, 5 spots on a dice, a star with 5 points, 5 little ducks/ 5 speckled frogs song.

We watched the 'Off we go' Numberblocks episode and have been practising putting the numbers **0-5 in the correct order**, using the language first, before, after, last.

Amazing Artists

This week we learnt more about our new artist for the term – **Wassily Kandinsky**, a Russian Painter. We recapped and explored the **primary** colours - red, yellow and blue again and what happens when we mix them together. We learnt how to use the **powder paints** to mix colours.

This week we learnt about **space** and in particular the moon. We learnt about the different **phases of the moon** and learnt the words whole, half and crescent.

We have learnt the names of the planets in the solar system and some facts about them.

We found out about the **British astronaut Tim Peake** and watched videos of astronauts in space doing everyday tasks like having lunch and brushing their teeth, which is very funny with no gravity to hold things down!
