Sound	Visual	Action	Digraph Rhyme
or	door 	Mime knocking on a door	or, or, knock on the door
ur	nurse 	Mime holding a purse	ur, ur, nurse with a purse

remember they are friends and hold hands.

Look carefully at the picture below, talk about it with your family. What can you see? What are the people doing?



Use your sounds to write some sentences about the picture.

You could use the phrase - 'I can see a ...' or you can write your own sentence such as 'The dog is running'.

Use the sound mat and tricky word card on our school website to help you with your sounds.

Remember your child needs to be writing this phonetically and as independently as possible, it **does not** have to be spelt correctly.

E.g.

The boy is flighing his kight. (The boy is flying his kite.)

The laidee is eeting an apl. (The lady is eating an apple.)

The dog is blak and wight. (The dog is black and white.)
