

Revision Schedule Term 4 and 5 2025 English for Mrs Goode and Mrs Barrett's Year 6s

This term we will be covering the remaining writing genres and areas of grammar we have not yet looked at as well as revisiting some from earlier in the year. We hope that the children will find this useful to develop their understanding and writing skills. We have included references to relevant pages in the CPG KS2 English Study and Question books. We will also continue to send home additional grammar homework fortnightly.
