HeartSmart: No way through isn't true and Don't forget to let love in.

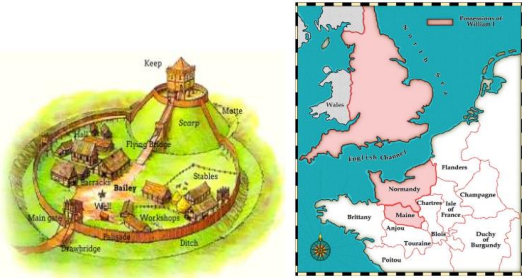
